INTRODUCTION



More than 2000 people are employed regularly on the Trans Alaska Pipeline System (TAPS) at pump stations, the Valdez Marine Terminal and offices in Anchorage, Fairbanks and Valdez. During construction season, there can be as many as 4,500 employees working to operate and maintain TAPS. The diverse workforce is comprised of both Alyeska Pipeline Service Company and contractor company employees.

This guide includes information about Alaska Native Program/Section 29 Designated and Reporting TAPS Contractors that provide services to Alyeska Pipeline Service Company and the job disciplines/skill sets required to work in these jobs.
